The new system replaces the building's original speakers, which were no longer fully functioning and were becoming a safety concern. The upgraded system provides better sound, improved equipment longevity and a simpler, more reliable setup for the many activities and events held at Kearns Arena. Public skating and shinny are scheduled throughout the season.
