Utilities

- Had an issue with our Neptune Belt Clip Transceiver for the R900 Meters. Sent it in to get worked on. Flocor (our distributor) will forward it onto Neptune and Flocor will send us a temporary one they have when we get closer to meter reading to use.
- Still appears to have a leak or other issue in the system somewhere. Can tell at the water plant. Not using too much more water than normal but noticeable in the pressure and flows at the plant.
