Carrot River Fire and Rescue Report

- 2023 budget has been approved. Last items have been ordered. Awaiting arrival.
- There were 11 emergency calls during the time period of January - April. With 4 of them in the R.M. – 1 alarms, 1 semi fire, 1 MVA and 1 medical. Town had 6 medicals and 1 alarms.
- May, June, and July calls so far are – 4 R.M. Rescue, 5 R.M. Fire, 1 R.M Medical, 7 Town Medicals and 1 Town Fire.
- Updating standard operating procedures to include new equipment and training levels.
- Continuing to update and go through other policies that need to be updated as well
- Fire residential and commercial prevention program is available for all businesses and members of the community. Anyone interested can contact Jordan Sinclair at 768-3331 for information.
- Training for 2023 – NFPA 1001 – Fire Committee has approved to use Action Training Online. Is live and crew has been using it regularly. Was granted free access to the Emergency Vehicle Operation course.
- Ongoing maintenance of equipment and gear.
- CRFR is at 21 members. Lt. Ed Warnock retired June 30th.
- TRES update. Just waiting for our training weekend coming up August 11 and 12. Working on getting enough vehicles for the weekend.
- Communities in Full Colour update. Started painting the fire hall last weekend. Half of the hall has been painted. Kevin Mazurek donated use of his electric scissor lift for the project.
- Weekend on call has been running since May long.
- Took 2 days off June 29th and 30
- Will be helping with the KCRA Rodeo this weekend. Fire Chief Jordan will be in the dunk tank Saturday at 5:30pm.
