- 2023 budget has been approved by Fire Committee and R.M. Council. Waiting for Town Councils approval
- There have been 4 emergency calls during the time period of January - March.
- Completed a partial inspection this week. Will finish up that one and 2 more on March 27th
- Updating standard operating procedures to include new equipment and training levels.
- Continuing to update and go through other policies that need to be updated as well

- Training for 2023 – NFPA 1001 Refresher to begin the year with working on getting the rest of the department up to that standard by the end of the year.
- Ongoing maintenance of equipment and gear.
- CRFR is at 21 members, we will be looking to recruit two more people.
- Will be continuing mutual aid agreement talks with PAGC, Red Earth, Shoal Lake and Cumberland house.
- Applied for the TREX program that SGI has released to the volunteer fire service.
- New AED has been purchased and put into service.
- 6 SCBA tanks are due for their hydro testing. Will be completed shortly.
- Yearly service of all emergency vehicles has been completed.
- Rescue truck has been repaired and is back in service.
- Was off the weekend of February 24th for meetings in Regina.
- Meet and greet was on February 28th and was a good turn out from the community and department members.
- Have overlooked fire drills at both the elementary and high schools recently.
