Carrot River Fire and Rescue:

The Town of Carrot River and the RM of Moose Range participate in an inter-municipal agreement for emergency services.

Carrot River Fire and Rescue is governed by bylaws establishing the department, the constitution, and the standard operating procedures of CRFR.

Officers:

The Chief is a permanent paid position. The Deputy Chief shall be the appointed (by both municipalities annually) for Carrot River Fire and Rescue. Other officers deemed necessary shall be appointed internally by the Chief. All officers shall have jurisdiction over the entire area within both municipal boundaries plus any areas identified in fire protection and/or rescue protection agreements signed by the municipalities.

Fire Investigation:

The municipality authorizes the Fire Chief to appoint the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency as local assistant investigators.

Fire Inspections:

The Town of Carrot River appoints a member of Carrot River Fire and Rescue as Fire Inspector for the municipality. This Fire Inspection Program is a requirement of the National Fire Code of Canada.

The program is available to all businesses, hotels/motels, apartment type occupancies and public occupancies including churches, halls, and recreation facilities in the Town of Carrot River.

The program is offered on a fee-for-service basis for locations within the Town boundaries and it should be conducted annually.

The Town will set out a schedule of fees for this service provided by the Town and will invoice the property owner for reimbursement of those fees. Fees charged will, at the very least, cover all expenses incurred by the Town to carry out the Fire Inspection of each property.

Carrot River Valley Mutual Aid Organization:

The Town of Carrot River is a participant in a mutual aid organization consisting of 15 municipalities



and 2 regional parks in the Northeast of Saskatchewan effective January 2006. Two service agreements are now in effect; emergency fire services and disaster services.

Emergency Measures Organization:

The Town of Carrot River, the R.M. of Moose Range and the Resort Village of Tobin Lake have jointly written a community emergency plan which provides guidance to the three municipalities to respond to an emergency. The document will not prevent or reduce the possibility of an emergency occurring. It will aid in providing a prompt and coordinated response thereby reducing human suffering and loss or damage to property.

The Emergency Management Operations Coordinator is a joint appointment by all three Councils.

Buildings – Protective Inspections:

The municipality has a Building Bylaw in place which regulates the erection, demolition, and inspections of buildings in the municipality. The Zoning bylaw regulates development and controls the use of land in the Town of Carrot River.

The municipality appoints a certified building official as the Town of Carrot River Building Inspector. The building inspector will contract with the Town for services at an agreed upon fee. The Town will invoice the property owner for reimbursement of those fees.
