



UPDATE July 2, 2024

The declared state of emergency has ceased, effective July 1, 2024.
Clean up continues for our community and will continue in the days to come.

Please read through this statement for the final details on debris clean up and garbage/recycle bin inventory and assessment. No more storm updates will be given.

Organic debris continues to be a major task, as such the Town Public Works staff will continue debris pick up as they are able until the storm debris has been managed. This means residents can pile fallen/removed trees (cut down into manageable sizes) and branches that they clean from their property along the street and back alley for pick up as needed. There are no set dates, these piles will be removed in an ongoing manner until a later date.

Garbage and recycle bins have been displaced and damaged following the storm. We will have a bin inventory and assessment on July 8th. ALL residents are asked to place bins at the curb for inventory to begin at 8:00am on July 8th. Bins will be inventoried, misplaced bins returned, broken bins replaced and properties that are missing bins will have new bins allocated to their property. Your help in this process is greatly appreciated!
